Unpacking

HVS-100ARC cards and their accessories are fully inspected and adjusted prior to shipment. Check your received items against the packing lists below. Check to ensure no damage has occurred during shipment. If damage has occurred, or items are missing, inform your supplier immediately.

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1. Installing the HVS-100ARC


The procedure below describes how to install an optional Arcnet card into an HVS-100 or HVS-110 unit.




Installing this option requires the unit interior to be accessed by opening the panel. Installation should only be performed by qualified technical personnel. The power should be turned OFF and all unit power cords disconnected before an installation is performed.

1-1. Installing the Arcnet Card into your HVS-100


- (1) Power Off your HVS-100 and disconnect the power cord(s).
- (2) Remove the mask plate at the upper left corner of the HVS-100 rear panel by removing the two screws on both sides of the plate.



(3) Remove the HVS-100 top panel by removing the five screws shown in the figure below.




(4) Unpack the Arcnet card (HVS-100ARC) and flex cable, and connect the cable to the card following Steps (a) to (d).



IMPORTANT


Electrical contacts (metal strips) of the cable connector must face the Arcnet card. Note that either cable connector can be used, but that the card does not work if the connector is connected in the wrong direction.

- (5) Place the Arcnet card inside the switcher along the side panel. Carefully position the Arcnet card so that its connectors pass through the opening of the mask plate removed in Step (2).
- (6) Secure the card with the supplied four W-sems screws and the connector with the supplied binding screw.
- (7) Connect the flex cable to the Main Card as shown below. Connect the cable to the Main Card in the same manner in Step (4).



Rear

- (8) Replace and secure the top panel back onto the chassis with its five screws.
 (9) Attach the supplied HVS-100ARC rating label on the rear panel as indicated in the figure below.




(10) Connect the power cable and power on the HVS-100.


The installation is now complete.

1-2. Installing the Arcnet Card into your HVS-110

- (1) Power Off your HVS-110 and disconnect the power cord(s).
- (2)Remove the five screws from on the back of the control panel on the front side of the HVS-110.



(3) Remove the three screws (circled) from the HVS-110 rear panel as shown.



(4) Gently lift the top panel up.


Disconnect the cables from the back of the top panel as indicated in the figure below and remove the top panel. Do **not** forcefully remove plugs and cables.




Back side of the control panel




(5) Remove the mask plate on the bottom left corner of the rear panel by removing the two screws on the plate.



(6) Unpack the Arcnet card (HVS-100ARC), shield plate and four W-sems screws and secure the shield plate to the back of the card with the four screws as shown below.




(7) Unpack flex cable, and connect them as shown below. Follow Step (4) in section 1-1 to connect the flex cable to the card.




IMPORTANT

Electrical contacts (metal strips) of the cable connector must face the Arcnet card. Note that either cable connector can be used, but that the card does not work if the connector is connected in the wrong direction.

- (8) Place the Arcnet card inside the switcher up against the side panel. Carefully position the Arcnet card so that its connectors pass through the opening of the mask plate removed in Step (5).
- (9) Use the small supplied screw to secure the connectors from the outside of the rear panel. Use the large supplied two screws to secure the card from the outside of the side panel.




(10) Connect the flex cable to the Main Card as shown below. Connect the cable to the Main Card in the same manner in Step (4) in section 1-1.



Front

- (11) Replace the top panel and connect the cables removed in Step (4) to the backside of the top panel.
- (12) Replace and secure the top panel back onto the chassis with the screws removed in Steps (2) and (3).
- (13) Attach the supplied HVS-100ARC rating label on the rear panel as indicated in the figure below.



(14) Connect the power cable and power on the HVS-110.

The installation is now complete.

2. Checking the Status Menu

Follow the procedure below to verify that the Arcnet card (HVS-100ARC) has been properly installed.

- (1) The MENU button on the control panel should blink when powered ON.
- (2) Press MENU, then press SETUP.
- (3) The SETUP menu top page appears in the menu display. Turn F1 to select STATUS and then press F1.

SETUP : >SYSTEM > I NPUT > OUTPUT > PANEL

MENU : >GPI / TLY > FUNCTION > EXT I / F > STATUS

(4) The [SETUP - STATUS] menu as shown below appears. Turn F1 to select OPTION and then press F1 or the page down button.

SETUP : >ALARM >VERSION >OPTION STATUS :

(5) The [SETUP - STATUS - OPTION] will appear. Verify that "INSTALLED" is displayed for the Arcnet card (HVS-100ARC).
